

EPA Renovation Repair & Paint (RRP)

Georgia Rules for certification and renewals

CERTIFIED RENOVATOR (individual)

If you were trained anytime between October 22, 2009 and **today's date**,
You have options in GA:

1. After 3 years you must take a 4-hour refresher course and certify with GA EPD
2. After 4 years you must take an 8-hour initial course and certify with GA EPD
3. Obtain a "Provisional License" for additional 12 months and pay \$300 (twice the fee), then take the 8-hour initial course after this additional 12 month provision.



If you do RRP work in any of the GRAY states above, you must be Certified by that State Program
If you work in the BLUE states, you must be Certified by Federal EPA
If you work in both, you must have both
